

## General Info

**Atmosphere** - We hold to a conservative position on attire and conduct. We reserve the right to ask any camper to change dress or behavior that may be deemed inappropriate. There is no physical contact between campers. There are separate swim times for girls and guys. Avoid wearing clothing with inappropriate advertising.

**Guys Clothing** - All shirts must have sleeves; no tank tops. Jeans or khakis may be worn throughout the day. Shorts need to come to the middle of the knee but should not be worn for evening services. Nice, casual clothing should be worn to the evening service. Recreational clothing needs to be comfortable, yet conservative.

**Girls Clothing** - All clothing worn for daily activities as well as for services should come to the middle of the knee. Loose-fitting pants are acceptable for daily activities. Skirts, dresses, or nice casual clothing should be worn for evening services. Shirts with sleeves are recommended; no tank tops or spaghetti strap tops should be worn. All swimsuits should be one piece or should meet in the middle.

**Things to Bring** - Sleeping bag or bedding materials, pillow, tennis shoes, Bible, pen, spending money, camera, flashlight, personal accessories, swimsuit, sunblock, towels, extra clothes for getting dirty, and insect repellent.

**Things to Leave Behind** - Do not bring food or snacks, cell phones, electronic and media devices, magazines, alcohol, cigarettes, non-prescription drugs, knives, firearms, paintballs, or fireworks.

**Personal items** - AGBC is not responsible for lost, broken, stolen or unclaimed personal property. Items not requested within 12 days will be donated or discarded. Requested items will be sent at the cost of the individual.

## Discounts Available!

**Multiple Camper Discount** — In order to help families that have more than one child, we are extending a discount for those who register multiple children for the SAME WEEK of camp. The first child will be charged for the full price of camp; additional children will be charged only \$160. No family will have to pay more than \$800 during a single week of camp for up to 6 children. Any children beyond six will be charged \$50 per child. Only the first child is eligible to receive an Early Bird discount.

**Sponsor Discount** — One sponsor may stay free of charge for every 15 campers from your church (while housing is available). Sponsor registration forms must be submitted. Sponsor couple housing is limited and cannot be guaranteed. Contact the camp office for availability.

**“Spirit” Coupon** — Purchase a Spirit Coupon and get the advantage on all the latest items at the AGBC store. The cost is \$25 if purchased by June 1; after June 1, the coupon is \$30 while supplies last. This is an additional cost separate from the registration fee.

**Early Bird Discounts** — Each camper who submits a registration and medical form along with the pre-registration fee of \$25 by February 15 will receive a \$20 discount for 1<sup>st</sup> Early Bird. If the camper sends in the said forms mentioned above along with the pre-registration fee of \$25 by April 1, then they will receive a \$10 discount for 2<sup>nd</sup> Early Bird.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Week of Camp Discount** — A camper attending a second week of camp will receive a discounted rate of \$115 for juniors and \$120 for teens.

**“Camp Friend” Gift Card** — Group leaders who invite and bring a new church group to camp will receive a complimentary meal at Ottawa’s famous Smoked Creations BBQ and a \$100 gift card.

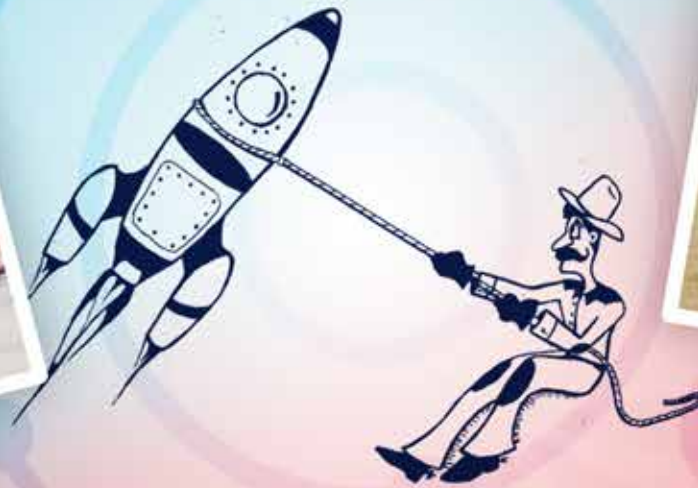
## From the Director

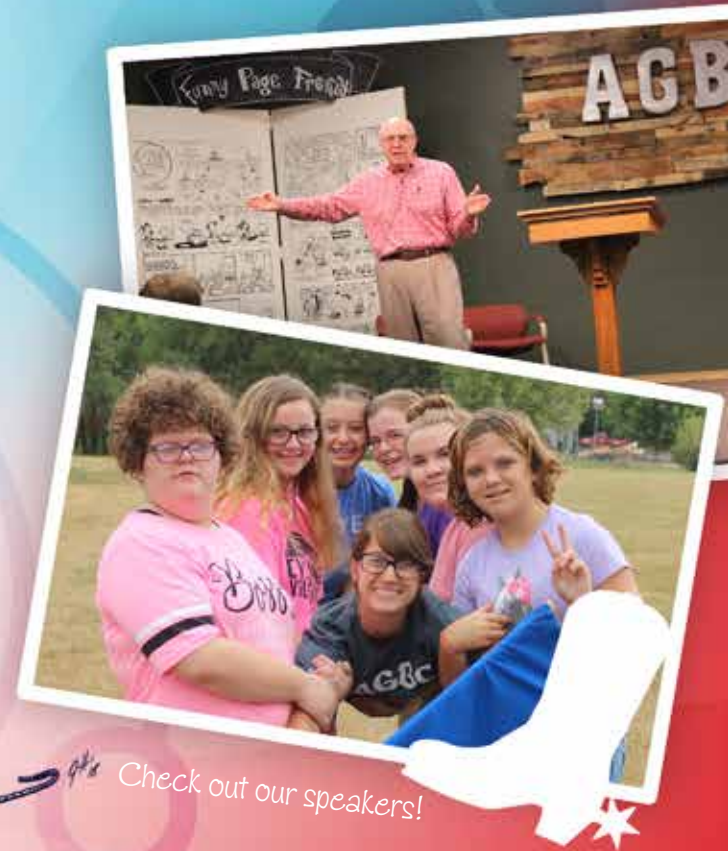
